ACTION ITEMS:

NEW BUSINESS:

- Discussion of how to reward our volunteers further, annual dinner paid for by the club suggested, committee to give further thought on the matter by next meeting.
- New headsets have been paid for, still waiting for delivery.
- New flags have been delivered.
- Vlad has arranged advertising through PCYC for Ride Days.
- Plans to offer optional higher level medical care (at a cost) for 1-5 Rider counts during Test and Tune days.
- Priorly agreed upon Grading and Golden Era was drafted, but has now been met with some disagreement, discussion ongoing. Interclub committee will carry out the grading.
- Format of Formula Baskerville was discussed and carried forward for further consideration.
- John Wilmore has approached Chris Price about a possible recommencement of sidecar racing in Tasmania. Currently under consideration by the committee.
- Value of the Lites 20 lap even during the 2 Hour questioned. Event was actually \$5 cheaper than last year. The event works out to be \$4.25 per lap, similar events at Broadford are \$8 per lap. The event will be repackaged next year.
- Brett checked commentary volume, cannot be turned up any further. Suggestion of handheld microphones or headsets better suited to commentary.
