Lots of interest in ride day riders converting to racers – Just need time for them to transition – all agreed that we are going in the right direction.</p> <p>All agreed for reintroduction of juniors into club rounds – even at a reduced costs for less racers – all agreed that we can't grow juniors if we don't have any junior race classes.</p> <p>Ride day people need help changing bikes over – Tracey has TMCC info sheet – Garth can help do up page on website how to get started – Kendal happy to help with brochure. Show race vs road bike same model. Have people who can help people who want to change bikes over. Belly pans – Tracey will send Bek info.</p> <p>Good to focus on junior class. Promote in bike shops. Come and try day. Allow a space for them in the program.</p> <p>Promoting formula Baskerville.</p> <p>Advertise – Kerry Knee will be down – can talk to people about changing bikes from ride to race.</p> <p>Need to promote on FB.</p> <p>Roll over.</p>	<p>Speak to interested ride day regulars and have an info session to help convert them to racing.</p> <p>Begin promoting for juniors.</p> <p>Create race group for past racers and ride day members – Race Your Mates style.</p>

<p><b>2 Hour Subcommittee</b></p> <p>Issues with communication between timing and Race Sec. Issues were dismissed by key officials.</p> <p>Many transponder and timing issues. We could get racers to buy their transponders – put the responsibility on them. Have the transponders handed out at the time of scrutineering. Use wand to check its assigned to correct bike/rider. We could rent the transponders to riders – they are responsible for them. What is the cost of this and what happens when it dies.</p> <p>Reiterate with riders who they go to with complaints or grievances. Have someone to deal with complaints and mediation who can diffuse situations and answer queries. Send out to riders that we won't be tolerating poor behaviour and what the consequence will be. Explain what it's cost us.</p> <p>Reserve spots on the boat – contact the TT line.</p>	<p>Send out a communication to riders about expectations of behaviour.</p> <p>Contact the TT line about reserving spots on the boat.</p> <p>Consider alternatives for transponders.</p>

They run 3 day race meetings already. Would like to be on the race Tasmania bill. James has spoken to Don. Nothing locked in regarding what categories would be run. Don keen for a combined SBK SSP class. Super karts? Worth getting them involved.</p> <p>Stand alone event in 2027. SBK, SSP, F3. (U500 / O500)</p>	<p>James will follow up</p>
<p><b>Club SOPs</b></p> <p>Winter project – Bek needs access to Google Drive</p>	<p>Get Bek access to Google Drive and remove Aaron.</p> <p>Bek and Craig will work on them.</p>
<p><b>Club Merchandise</b></p> <p>Sold 49/50 2hr shirts, SRCT shirts and stubbie holders. More S/M next time. Need more S/M in club shirts. We are missing jackets. We have designs ready for caps and hoodies. We can look into singlets.</p>	<p>Look into more merch options and keep stock on hand.</p>
<p><b>Race Suits in Container</b></p> <p>Decision to hold off on organising the containers until later in the year. Currently too wet and would make too much mess in the mud. Also section had been locked off due to shed works to unable to get vehicles close to the container.</p>	<p>Container working bee.</p>

<p><b>Timing</b></p> <p>Bek has organised Mateo to shadow Graeme at next race round.</p> <p>Reach out to local sporting car club and let their timing person know it’s a paid role if they’re interested.</p> <p>Jamie and Chris were training on the weekend.</p> <p>How they charge – if we sell them to people.</p> <p>Find out from Graeme what the deal is with them and get the ones from the container and put a battery in them. Put onus on the competitors to have their own.</p>	<p>Contact sporting car club.</p>
<p><b>Pizzas at Ride/Race Days</b></p> <p>Michael Webb has offered to put on pizzas at a ride/race day. Bek will talk logistics.</p> <p>Bek to Follow up and report back.</p> <p>Need someone with RSA to run bar. Jamie has one. Mia happy to help too. Need someone to make it their own and help organizing things.</p> <p>Jamie can renew his. Virginia will look into it. Club will reimburse.</p> <p>Bek apply for food permit and alcohol permit for the 2hr.</p> <p>Having someone who can play music – need to find out if we need a permit. Breath tester.</p>	<p>Bek to contact Michael.</p>
<p><b>Radios</b></p> <p>Number same as flag points – people sign them in and out.</p> <p>Club to consider buying more to cover the flag points. Geoff knows people who can sell them. Can get them cheaper.</p> <p>Geoff can get the radios cheaper but problem is the headsets as they need a special adapter. Icom make similar radio. Headsets are cheaper. \$25 each for private channel. Will get quotes for all.</p>	<p>Bek to create radio sign out sheet.</p> <p>Geoff to organise a quote.</p>
<p><b>Set Up / Pack Up</b></p> <p>Create a roster so the load is shared. A check list. Need to let people know that there’s a lot to do.</p> <p>Get more cheap carabiners.</p>	<p>Create roster.</p> <p>Bek to create checklist.</p>

<p><b>Officials</b></p> <p>Trouble with first timers not listening to instructions properly. Questions about riders sitting on their bike for recovery and the safety of the trailer itself. There was wire falling off the trailer. Geoff will find out about enclosing the trailer with sides and a floor. Look into something we can pick up the chairs in too.</p> <p>Send message to Ben at MTAs to find out requirements.</p> <p>Needs a solid floor and comp panels up to the first rail. Get a couple of roll in stands. Use Tom’s trailer for sidecar pick ups. Need to make sure there is a reserved spot for the van.</p>	<p>Geoff to enquire about enclosing the trailer.</p>
<p><b>Treasurers Report</b></p> <p>What’s come in, what’s gone out. What we’ve got. Delegation of finances. Would be good if we could get a monthly report from Hans.</p> <p>Need to sort out a few of the figures. BBQ – social events – Saturday bbq to get people to stick around and ask questions. Could get it going on the February ride race weekend.</p> <p>Emphasise the price increase – emphasise refund if you don’t go out on track.</p>	<p>Hans to organise monthly treasurers report.</p>
