Business Arising from Previous Meeting:

Jeremy Huddleston wanted to skip business arising from previous meeting & refunds due to the no confidence vote from last event and call for an sgm

Call for business as this meeting is not the sgm, sgm to be held at a later date, the agm will be held off the back of the sgm.

Jeremy called for general business, members stated the minutes from previous meeting were not available on the SRCT website, Rebekah stated she did not know if the minutes from the previous meeting were on the web site.

Rebekah stated it was a very small group of members stated no confidence in the current committee and the current running of race meetings

No one was singling out Jeremy it was the running of the committee in his absence

No financial report, Rebekah stated there had not been one for 5 yrs, Chris price working with Hans, Rebekah stated if anyone had bothered to turn up to meetings they would know of the financial situation, she also stated we break even/make a profit of approx. \$300 per ride day

James spoke about race day losses of approx. \$3k-3.5k due to low attendance, with losses starting at approx. 40 race entries, Shaun said we conduct ride days to pay for race days.

Discussions regarding minutes, finance reports current updates on SRCT Web site, Garth Newton looks after the web site.

Rebekah stated her role as the Club Administrator is to take direction from the President and Vice president only.

Previous action items, arrange a Treasurers report mthly was discussed, Chris Price has done a magnificent job of the Club finances for a long period of time. Current members not knowing the financial situation of the club makes decisions difficult on financial direction.

Jeremy stated as volunteers we do as much as we can juggling full time employment, family life etc and that the club is not here to make a profit, we are here to make the club run.

Eric made the point of radios being stolen from a member's car, Jeremy stated 7-8 radios, were they claimed on insurance, Jeremy was not aware of any insurance claim being made. The member offered to pay for replacement, James said the radios have been replaced like to like. Geoff Webb researched what is the best replacement.

Kendal asked if we could put more onus on the user for damage. Majority stated no Rebekah said the sign on sheet but the onus on the user.

Track set up/pack up is still an issue with the same few people having to do it.

Bins not being emptied prior to us hiring the venue, speak to Don Potter regarding this.

Recovery trailer modification to hold fluid with a floor and sides, Eric has organised for the mods for cost of materials.

Treasurer/club finances discussed again, Hans living in Melbourne but happy to continue with the roll, Cris still involved, Rebekah stated the financial report will be presented at the AGM

Members spoke about the obtaining of permits for events and were concerned they were not being applied for early enough, Rebekah stated police will not except to far in advance and Mtas will not issue a permit without Officials being listed. She also

stated Peter Woods and Gabby would be the CoC and Steward for the remaining rounds this year.

Members asked if there was a clear guide to Flaggies, Rebakah stated there is not they are trained on the day. Shaun talked to MST regarding lights, Jeremy spoke about screens, Motorsports Tasmania would like more insight into what we would like.

Gus enquired about why the \$40 vouchers were introduced, Rebakah said the Club was losing money big time, we pay half, and the bike shop pay half. Can we offer half days for flaggies? Having a list of ppl we can contact, and a member to coordinate the volunteers.

Practice day proceeding a race day, riders not entered on Sunday cannot ride in the race groups. Many members and riders agree to the safety concerns around this.

Admin role to be advertised, Postpone advertising until the agm

James contacted Davo Johnson re coaching days, Shaun asked if Davo had the appropriate licences etc under Ma guidelines

Virginia and Shaun to talk to Dylan regarding updating the Club website

Ride day entries, and refunds all sorted, price rise on the day on the day registrations, online numbers have increased. Ridernet a problem, can we encourage Mtas to fix it.

Garages refunded, does the club keep half the hire amount, Has Ridernet completed the refund as Rebakah clicks refund but ridernet has to complete the refund. Pay system not working correctly attempted contact with Don Potter, he was meant to turn up but didn't.

Jeremy raised a Club ambassador role, a young rider??? To advertise the club and ride day/race days in general

Gus raised the Junior class, 2 hr promotion including juniors, Gus is happy to help out with getting it up and running.

Eric asked about the donated leathers in the Club container, he was under the impression they were to be thrown out, Jeremy said no

Shaun asked Jeremy to talk to ***** regarding position descriptors, Jeremy stated he has tried to contact ***** numerous times but does not answer his phone.

Access to Google drive requested, ***** was the last to have access, committee have tried to contact ***** , *****.

Rebekah said pd's had been completed she remembers seeing them but states they are too high level, she wanted them broken down to day to day level.

Jeremy stated that James, Rebekah, Craig and himself would be stepping down from the committee

Eric put his hand up and said he would be good to be the go to person for any rider conflict.

Future 2x4 event discussion – most would like to see it happen Superbikes and 600 Supersport to be the classes

Rebekah stated ***** just ignores everything ***** , Jeremy said he would try and contact *****.

James handling Club merchandise, people waiting for 2+ years for shirts, Jeremy had posted a large number of items he was given with names on them. Also boxes of trophies in the container with names on them.

Timing, riders purchasing their own transponders, the club to sell the current ones, Riders to be responsible for the charging etc. Graeme in transitioning out of timing, training two others.

Discussions around computer for the 2Hr nothing committed.

Working bee to tidy containers, check equipment etc. Create an up to date log of all equipment.

Events grants the club were eligible to apply for, they need to know what the event can provide for Tasmania.

Discussion regarding ride day participants transitioning to racing as race entries are low, this includes the juniors. Posters and training as most ride day participants don't know what they have to do to go racing. Info sessions in the lunch break by racers and hand out an information flyer. John was going to have a look to see if he still had information regarding this. The Mom's is a manual using high level language can we break this down into something more user friendly.

Michael Webb offered to do pizza's on ride/race days. Someone needs to contact him to see if he is still interested

Brett asked how much money does the club make on late fees, Entries not open long enough, Rebekah stated entries were open just not advertised. She stated once again you can't open an event until the officials positions have been filled, the system won't let you. Mtas have to sign off before we can open the event. Shaun said Mtas are suppose to appoint the Steward, Jeremy stated they do not. Rebekah stated there were 5 late entries 10%, members stated this was too many.

Sgm as requested by members will be 16th April, directly followed by the AGM. To be advertised on the Club website and facebook.

Tim Airey asked Rebekah if the ride day on the 12 April was till going ahead, Rebekah stated it was but had not been advertised.

Club does not have enough key officials, need to encourage more on board.

Gus asked if there was a minimum age for roles, 16 for flaggies, 18 for other key roles, Rebekah stated.
